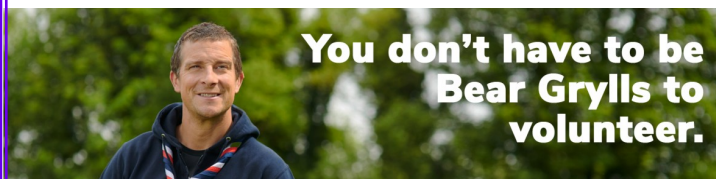

WORTH ABBEY NEWS AUGUST - SEPTEMBER 2021

The monks of Worth Abbey, the Abbey of Our Lady Help of Christians, announce the election of Dom. Mark Barrett as the seventh Abbot of Worth Abbey on Tuesday 8th June 2021. Biographical details of Abbot Mark and the date of the Abbatial Blessing will be announced in due course.

Worth Abbey is open for Mass and private prayer in line with government guidelines.

There are three Masses during the week - Saturday at 5pm, The Vigil Mass for Sunday at 9.30am and Tuesday at 10am. You are welcome to participate but please respect current COVID guidelines.

The Parish Mass at 5pm on Saturday is streamed - the code is <https://vimeo.com/event/597192>. Your presence at this mass will be assumed to signify your agreement with streaming. If you do not wish to be visible, please avoid the two front benches around the church.

The church will be open for private prayer at 2pm on Thursday when there will also be the opportunity for confession. The entrance for private prayer will be via the East Door (on the lower level) not from the Narthex. **Confession is also available on Sunday morning at 9am** (prior to Mass) in the Unity Room.

AFTERNOON WI

Judy Anderson from Great Ormond Street Hospital for Children (GOSH) was our zoom speaker for June. Judy has spoken to us previously, but in that time there have already been many changes and advancements to the hospital. The Zayed Centre was completed in 2019. The centre researches rare diseases in children. There is now a Sight & Sound Centre. This specialist outpatient facility includes quiet waiting spaces, a sensory garden and interior design tailored to the needs of children with sight and hearing loss. We heard about some of the interesting facts about GOSH. There are 450 beds in 50 wards, 4,500 staff of which 60 are medical staff. They see over 600 children every day, 50% from outside London, and 30% are under 4. Judy's talk was accompanied by videos of some of the children and their families who have benefited from treatment at GOSH. The current climate has effected their charity fund raising, and as ever they are desperate for funds to continue their amazing work. A very interesting talk, and a very worthy cause.

In July we will be having a Social Meeting in our President Kay's lovely garden. A chance for us all to meet up again, and catch up after a long time. August will see us back in Kay's garden again for our Summer Afternoon Tea meeting - thank you Kay! At these meetings we hope to have raffles, sales table, games & quizzes etc. Lots to look forward to.

We hope that with the new rules we will soon be able to meet up as before, and see our speakers in person rather than on Zoom!

At our monthly zoom meeting on 3rd June, our President, Jan Albury, introduced Hazel Child who would talk to us about her work as a Music Therapist. This was the first presentation that Hazel had given on zoom, so it was a learning curve evening for her as well as a very interesting one for the members present. Hazel showed us her beautiful harp as well as other items she uses in her professional life. She works with children who have special needs as well as children and adults who have been traumatised by war and other conflicts. She explained that people with dementia and those with acquired brain injuries relating to health issues can also be helped. Hazel was heartily thanked for her fascinating insight into a complex method of utilising music in all its formats to assist with education and therapy.

Decluttering is something that many of us will have attempted during the pandemic lockdowns, so the subject of our guest speaker, Mimi Bogeland on 1st July, was of great interest. The aim of her company is to help people "put their houses in order" by decluttering them. She said that many people needed motivation to be able to tackle it so she talked us through some techniques which might help us. She advises her clients to sort out their possessions by category. Those which are sentimental could either be retained or gifted to family and friends. Other articles could be donated to a charity or advertised on a Freecycle website. She understood how difficult such an undertaking is, but assured us that we would feel so much better after we had completed the task. It was a very informative presentation.

Crawley Down Environment Group and Infrastructure Working Party

The Crawley Down Environment & Infrastructure Working Party has been formed by Worth Parish Council to help it engage with other key stakeholders in the Village, such as the Residents Association, to create a Vision for the way that the Village could develop over the short and medium term to make it an even more desirable place to live and raise a family.

As an example, there is a small group who have organised litter picking; they can now borrow equipment from the Council for this and get more publicity for what they are doing. Indeed, there was a Litter Pick on 10th July when, in slightly inclement weather, a team of 10 met in the car park.

This is a small example, bigger challenges are there, such as how to find a future use for the Royal Oak site and integrate that with

other changes in the Village centre that would be of benefit.

Other issues such as anti-social behaviour, including speeding, are often raised and CCTV is being considered as one of the measures to deal with this. Closer relationships are also being established with Sussex Police.

Neighbourhood Watch

**Would you be interested in either helping to establish
or join a new Neighbourhood Watch Scheme in your area?**

The community spirit that we see in your area is very strong and we feel that this could further be strengthened with the setting up of a Neighbourhood Watch Scheme.

The benefits of such a scheme:

- Crime prevention advice.
- Greater awareness of current issues in your area.
- Support from area co-ordinators and a well-established and pro-active board.

You would be supporting the Police in keeping your area a safe place to live and work.

There are two ways in which a scheme can be established.

The most common way is to have a set up meeting with all interested parties in a road/area. Due to current restrictions this could be done by virtual means. After this meeting then a Neighbourhood Watch sign could then be ordered (there is a small fee involved). This then makes the scheme visible and members have the option to display a sticker in their windows.

An alternative way is what's called a 'Covert' scheme. This is an option where there is a positive response from a road/area but potential members are not keen to have the scheme or their membership known and no signage is displayed in the road/area. However benefits mentioned above are the same.
